CONSTRUCTION:

HULL: Laminated G.R.P. hull with internal fiberglass hull liner, reinforced with unidirectional roving.
DECK: Balsa sandwich for stiffness plus thermal and acoustic insulation. Deck liner for additional insulation and easy maintenance.
INTERIOR WOOD: Varnished Cherry Stained Mahogany

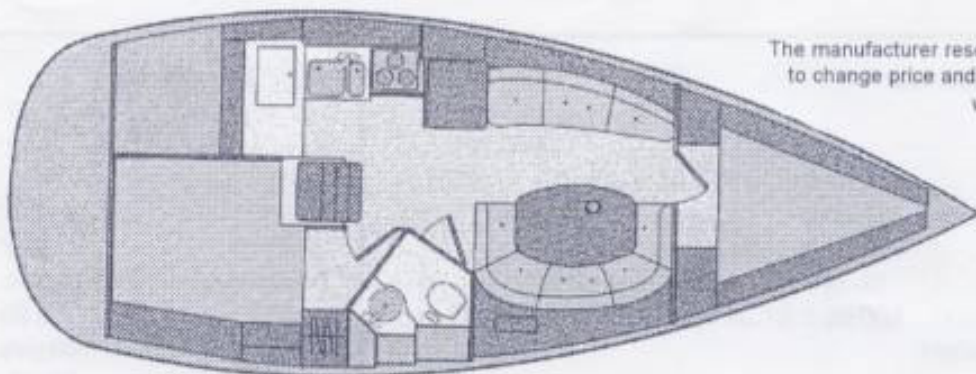
